


INTEGRATING DRAMA AND TEXT

Rain School (click title for text)



Age Levels: Lower Elementary

Description: Students first explore their own experiences of going to school for the first time to then investigate the experiences of a group of children in Africa who need to build their own school.

STEP ONE	ON/OFF SNAPSHOT CIRCLE (Click for strategy facilitation handout) In preparation for reading/listening to the story, students creatively express their feelings on a first day at school.	On/Off Circle Snapshot
STEP TWO	ADD-ON SNAPSHOT (Click for strategy facilitation handout) In preparation for reading/listening to the story, pairs of students dramatize how older brother/sisters might react to/help a younger sibling prepare for a first day at school.	Add-on Shapshot
STEP THREE	READ PART ONE (Marked in the Text)	
STEP FOUR	SCULPTED SNAPSHOT (Click for strategy facilitation handout) Students shape each other's bodies to show what the characters did in the first part of the story.	Sculpted Snapshot

STEP FIVE	PAIR SNAPSHOT (Click for strategy facilitation handout) Pairs of students create images of the students in the story building the school.	
STEP SIX	READ PART TWO (Marked in the text)	
STEP SEVEN	Discuss how the students might have reacted to the change in their school.
